Objective: To provide strategies for supporting pupils and develop sustainable interventions

Provision: Individual hourly sessions to targeted pupils

4. Increased provision of Music Therapy

Objective: To provide strategies for supporting more pupils and to develop sustainable interventions

Provision: Individual hourly sessions to targeted pupils

5. Provision of Intervention Officer

Objective: To address the recommendation of Ofsted by providing a link between home and school regarding attendance. Develop strategies for supporting families to encourage their children to attend school regularly

Provision: Meetings, home visits and engagement strategies
