Pupils can develop the knowledge they achieved during KS3 and work towards the FCSE that helps pupils develop communication skills routinely acquired at levels of study equivalent to National Curriculum Levels 4, 5 or 6</p> <p>Pupils in Years 11-14</p> <p>Pupils can take GCSE Spanish, FCSE or Level 1 or 2 Certificate in Spanish</p>
