## Spanish Curriculum Overview

<p>Students will be introduced to different topics at an E1 level.</p> <p>They study the following themes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Theme 1 My World</b></li><li>• <b>Theme 2 Holidays</b></li><li>• <b>Theme 3 Leisure</b></li></ul>	<p>As students gain confidence and increase their vocabulary, they will revisit the same Themes as in Year 7, embedding new words and tenses.</p> <p>They will continue studying the following themes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Theme 1 My World</b></li><li>• <b>Theme 2 Holidays</b></li><li>• <b>Theme 3 Leisure</b></li></ul>	<p>Students will work towards their ELC and produce the required assignments in order to achieve the qualification. The assignments will be based on Speaking and Listening, Writing and Reading skills.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Theme 1 My World</b></li><li>• <b>Theme 2 Holidays</b></li><li>• <b>Theme 3 Leisure</b></li></ul>	<p>Students in Years 10 can study Spanish as an Option. Students can develop the knowledge they achieved during KS3 and work towards the FCSE that helps students develop communication skills routinely acquired at levels of study equivalent to National Curriculum Levels 4, 5 or 6. The qualification bridges the gap between ELC and GCSE.</p>	<p>Students in Year 11 can study Spanish as an Option. Students can continue working towards FCSE. Students making outstanding progress could also have the opportunity to get an iGCSE or a GCSE.</p>
