Digital Media Curriculum Overview



The Digital Media qualification is offered at L1 Introductory Award, Certificate, and Diploma. The qualification is designed around practical skills and tasks that place an emphasis on our pupils demonstrating what they can do rather than what they know in theory. The Digital Media curriculum gives pupils the opportunity to acquire and develop appropriate skills to complete tasks and demonstrate a level of achievement. This enables our pupils to progress to a higher qualification or further learning. The pupil will study core and optional units. The units cover activities such as designing a digital product, creating storyboards, shooting moving images, and recording audio.

The units in these qualifications are internally assessed and externally moderated by external standards verifiers.

In KS4 pupils will follow Award or Certificate qualification depending on their strength. Those who pass any level in KS4 and choose Digital Media as one of their options in KS5 will progress to the certificate or diploma qualification.

- Learning to work with others to create an advertisement for a set brief
- Taking on an individual role in the preproduction and production process.

Unit DM10 Shooting a Short Film

- Learning to develop the skills needed to plan a film shoot and capture footage
- Using these skills in a practical situation for a specific purpose.
