## 6<sup>th</sup> Form Curriculum Overview



### Year 12:

Pupils are expected to continue to study towards qualifications in English and Maths. Alongside these, they can choose to study for qualifications offered through our Pathways programmes.

They study for the following qualifications:

- BTEC Workskills: E3 to L2 (Award, Certificate and Diplomas through partnership with Young Enterprise and The Prince's Trust)
- Gateway Independent Living Skills – E3

Pupils are required to undertake weekly shopping and budgeting tasks such as food shopping, and are also required to prepare their lunches throughout the academic year.

Pupils can also select from our Pathway programme. They can decide if they wish to start a new pathway course at Award level and build on these over the next three years to and reach Certificate or Diploma level.

### Year 13:

Pupils continue to study towards qualifications in English and Maths at Functional Skills levels or at GCSE. Alongside these, they can choose to study for qualifications offered through our Pathways programmes.

They study for the following qualifications:

- BTEC Workskills: E3 to L2 (Award, Certificate and Diplomas through partnership with Young Enterprise and the Prince's Trust)

Pupils will continue to study their selected Pathway courses chosen in year 12. The aim is to achieve the Diploma level by the end of year 14.
