1. Additional literacy support

Objective: To improve progress within literacy levels.

3. Continued provision of Art Therapy

Objective: To provide strategies for supporting students and develop sustainable interventions.

4. Continued provision of Music Therapy

Objective: To provide strategies for supporting students and develop sustainable interventions.

5. Continued provision of Mentoring support

Objective: To provide strategies for supporting students and develop sustainable interventions.

6. Continued provision of after school clubs (including Saturday School and sourcing new providers)

Objective: To provide opportunities for students during and after school, easing childcare issues for families.

7. Subsidy of school educational visits and overnight residential trips

Objective: To eliminate economic barriers to engagement and access to these experiences.
